Carpet Fire

Fire Incident

- MFB suggested at the time that the fire could have been deliberately lit
- Man pled guilty to arson and criminal damage after being arrested after tyres were set ablaze in Brooklyn

Controls

- Cameras on weighbridge covering more of the site
- Have foreman on site
- Increased security patrols
- Install hydrants on site
- Second water truck onsite with fire fighting capabilities



EPA Press Release

We dispute the allegation of breach of Licence and that we are a contributor to the odour and we are following up with EPA. We also dispute some of the language such as "smoke" and "burning waste" that is inaccurate and misleading.

Other odour sources at adjacent sites

- Burning of industrial waste as a method of disposal on an almost daily basis
- Sporadic burning of electrical cable to remove plastic cover



Hotspots/Odour

Sunshine Groupe does not burn waste

- Hotspots are areas of high temperature composting taking place beneath the surface within the landfill mass.
- Hot spots occur naturally in all landfills, including ours.

Control in Place

- Daily odour check at site boundaries
- Landfill temperature monitoring (IR Thermometer)
- Consultant engaged to make recommendations on hot spot management

The ongoing smothering and management of hotspots has continued since EPA inspection

Dust / Roads

Additional controls since last presentation

- Hire water truck to wash road
- Street sweeper dedicated to Bunting Road
- Cost \$15-20k/month

Taking clay at the moment from Rail Crossing Removal works. Working with the client to put in further controls.

Our plan to have road trucks drive only sealed surfaces has been held up due to reconfiguring recycling plant. Recycling Plant expected to come on line September/October 2016.

Stockpile Heights

- Start reclaiming in August
- Hold up due to waiting on recycling plant and approval of the new cell
